Additionally, Kellogg Community College (KCC) is also working with FireKeepers to provide computer access for job applicants on its main campus in Battle Creek. KCC's Computer Lab, located at 450 North Avenue, Ohm Building, Room 9, will be open today and Friday from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.

Beginning January 27, an additional computer lab will be open to applicants on Tuesday evenings from 8:00 a.m. until 8:00 p.m. The lab location is at Student Employment Services, inside the Student Center, next to the cafeteria.

Job Eligibility

To be eligible to work at FireKeepers Casino, applicants must be at least 18 years old and must undergo a thorough background check to receive a gaming license.
